

**Construction Permit** – Limited to 2 overtime permits per site no matter how large or small the project. They are only given to the general contractor and they can give them to whomever they wish relative to their project but we typically limit the range of where they can park.

**Special Event Permit** – These are allowed under the special event process but typically do not involve on-street parking unless they plan to close a road as part of an event.

**Road Closure or Barricade Permit** – May be short term or long term. In either case we limit how much they can block off at any given time and try to limit the duration as best as possible. Over the past year we have been limiting the length of the permit forcing contractors, etc. to come back to us to extend their permit. It allows us to re-evaluate their plan.

This is all we do permit wise in the area. There are other types of permits issued by other cities that we should probably consider one way or another. I will send you a list in a few minutes.
